Projections

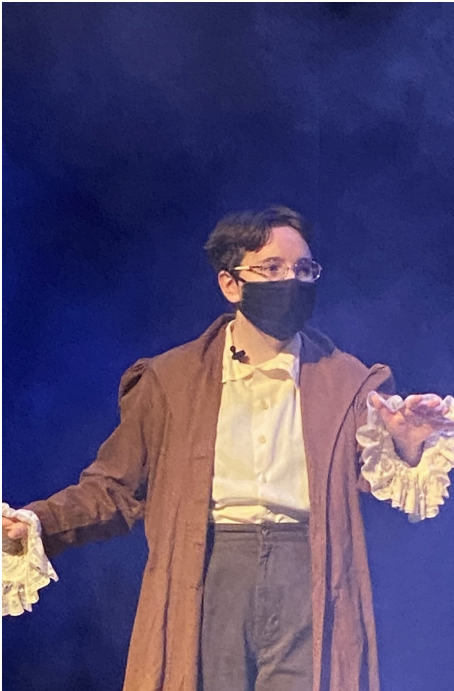

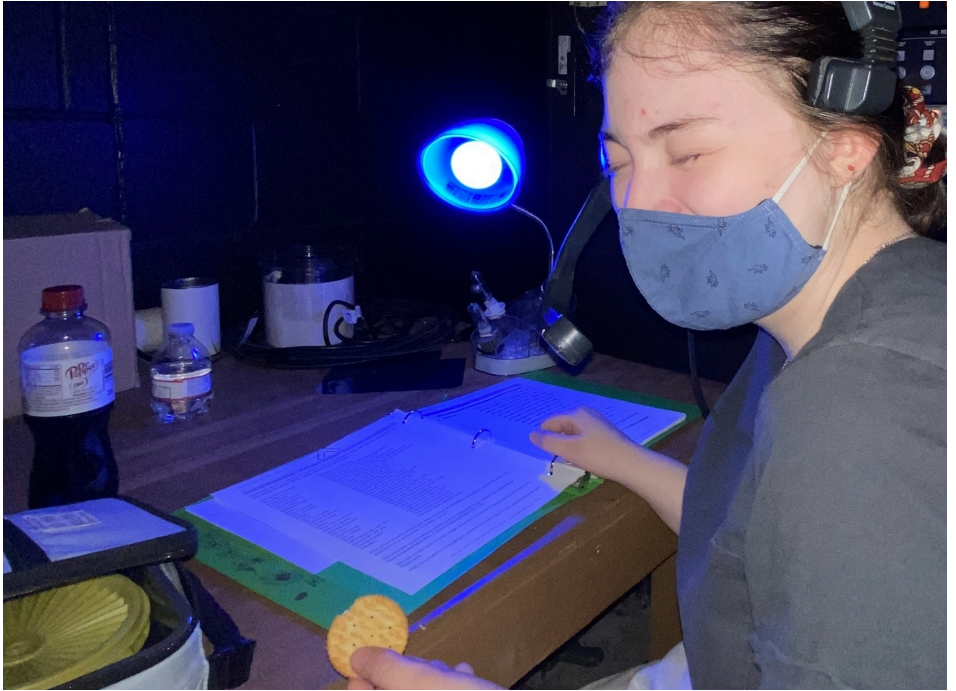
